To that end, we have expectations of each member that participates in Central Baptist Mission endeavors. Whether the team member is a member of Central or not, they commit to:

- Have an attitude like that of Christ Jesus.
- Maintain a flexible and positive attitude for the duration of the trip. Plans change and surprises happen, it is imperative that we roll with it and keep a Christ-like attitude.
- Follow the leadership of the team leader in areas concerning safety, responsibility, guidelines, etc.
- Honor the expectations of the host mission organization and/or church with which we are in partnership.
- Abstain from consuming alcohol and tobacco on mission trips.
- Be above reproach when it comes to staying out of lodging quarters of the opposite sex.
- Under no circumstance allow myself to be isolated with a member of the opposite sex, whether they be a member of our team, another team, or locals of the ministry with which we are working.
- Refrain from following translators or nationals on social media.
- Address any issues or disagreements with a Christ-like attitude and will include the team leader when/if necessary.
- *Change clothes in the privacy of their restroom or tent.*
- Make choices that honor God, respect the culture, follow the guidelines, and point others to Jesus.
